Gift Aid your pledge

If you pay tax on your income (on most income including pensions the tax is likely deducted at source) then please tick the Gift Aid box.

Once the box is ticked, we can claim back the tax that you have already paid on the money. It does not matter how large or small the gift is - The Church can get an extra 28 pence from the government for every pound you give to the Parish .

1. Please notify the parish if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
2. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the parish, it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
3. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the parish reclaims on your donations in the tax year.
4. If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax the parish reclaims, you should cancel your declaration. (see note 2)

If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim extra tax relief in your Self Assessment return.

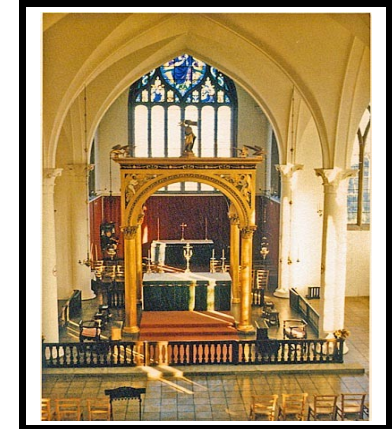
If you are unsure whether your donation qualifies for tax relief, please ask the Parish Gift Aid co-ordinator or you can ask your local tax office for a leaflet about Gift Aid.

Important Information.

The Friends of St. Philip, Cosham is a sub group of St,Philip's Cosham PCC, (the PCC). All monies raised by the Friends via membership fees or donations will be held by the PCC but controlled and used under the direction of the Friends of St.Philip. For the support, maintenance and development of the Church.

In the unlikely event of the Friends being disbanded by the PCC, all monies raised by the Friends via membership fees or donations will pass to the PCC but will remain a "reserved" fund under the financial accounting rules and used for the purposes described above.
